In Offshore Navigation (Junior Navigation), the student will continue to use GPS as the primary position sensor, as they learned to do in Marine Navigation (Piloting) and Advanced Marine Navigation (Advanced Piloting). However, the offshore environment poses many different elements for consideration by the navigator. Ocean currents, wind, and sea state all affect a vessel's performance over the longer passages.
